CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All resident Australian competitors must be current financial members of Pistol Australia.
2. Competitors may be asked to prove they are a current member of their State/Territory association.
3. Entries close Friday 31 January 2023. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Organising Committee. Entry Fees must accompany the Entry Form and or payment notification supplied.
4. Entries without full payment will not be accepted.
5. Phone entries will not be accepted.
6. Where match rules permit, electroplated and copper-washed ammunition is allowed. Full metal jacketed (FMJ) projectiles are prohibited on all ranges.
7. Provisional State/Territory team lists to be received no later than 14 February 2023 to assist squadding.
8. Pistol licences/permits, and PA holster proficiency cards must be submitted for checking at Equipment Control.
9. Competitors, officials, and visitors to the range will be required to sign the Range Register each day.
10. Competitors, officials, and visitors must wear enclosed footwear, eye and ear protection as required.
11. Competitors are not permitted to wear tank tops, garments with loose fitting necks or camouflage clothing.
12. ISSF and Pistol Australia Rules will be followed as closely as is practicable.
13. WA 1500 Competition at DPC will be on static targets with an audible horn indicating start and stop signals.
14. Firearms and gun boxes must not be left unattended anywhere on the facilities at either Club.
15. Handguns and competitors' equipment (gun cases, bags etc) are not permitted in club rooms at any time.
16. Signage will indicate Safe Areas. These areas are to be used for any handling of uncased firearms.
17. No ammunition is permitted in any Safe Area.
18. Mobile phones used on the range must be in Flight Mode, before entering any ranges.
19. Smoking/Vaping is not permitted on any range at any time. Please use designated smoking areas.
20. Alcohol is not permitted on any range at any time. BYO alcohol is not permitted at any time.
21. Alcohol may be consumed at the conclusion of the competitor's program for the day.
22. **Media release:** by entering this competition, you acknowledge that all results will be published on the PA, PNT, PPC and DPC websites and social media platforms. You also acknowledge that video footage and your photograph may be taken during this competition and may be published on all PA websites, social media platforms and/or TV.
